



Action Plan

Site Safety Culture

- The construction industry promotes the safety culture of “Roles and Responsibilities” and “Caring Community”, guarding the lives of frontline workers with concerted efforts.
- The Construction Industry Council (CIC) will organise targeted safety training programmes in stages in end 2022, strengthening the stakeholders’ awareness of “Safety Roles and Responsibilities” as well as the concept and practice of “Caring Community”.

Design for Safety

- The CIC will publish the “Guidelines on Design for Safety” in end 2022 and arrange relevant training for the industry.
- The Government, the CIC and the industry will collaborate proactively to promote a wider adoption of “Design for Safety” in public and private works projects. A seminar will be conducted within 2023, inviting public and private organisations to share their experience of application.

Smart Site for Safety

- The CIC will publish the “Guidelines on Smart Site Safety” in end 2022 for the industry’s application. The CIC will continue to enrich its “smart product catalogue” to facilitate the industry in procuring suitable products.
- The Government will in early 2023 mandate the application of the “Smart Site Safety System”(SSSS) in key public works projects, and in the first half of the year subsidise private works through the Construction Innovation and Technology Fund (CITF) to adopt SSSS more extensively.

Improvement of Site Safety Management System

- On the basis that “site safety is each and every person’s responsibility”, the industry will proactively explore the improvement of the site safety management system for the different parties involved in the site (including the managerial staff at different levels and the workers) and the feasible directions. The Committee on Construction Safety under the CIC will follow up the task and formulate timetable for execution.
- The CIC will publish “Guidelines on Temporary Works Management Plan” in end 2022 for the industry’s application, strengthening the industry’s awareness of temporary works management plan, and will arrange relevant training.
