Presiding officer Lennie Samuel is scrutinising reports from various companies involved in the project.




In South Africa:


### **Failure of Temporary Works**







- Delay of construction programme
- Economic loss
- Damage of reputation of the organisations involved

Civil Engineering Works & Building Works

#### **Timeframe**

Entry submission: 2016Q4

Assessment period: 2017Q1

#### > Assessment Panel

 Representatives from DEVB, CIC, professional bodies, consultants, contractors, etc.

#### **Assessment Criteria**

- Review of options
  - Identify & eliminate hazards
  - Reduce high risk temporary conditions for each option
- > Temporary works design
  - Fix risks inherent in temporary works
  - Innovation
- Temporary works execution
  - Ensure what designed is what is built
  - Allocate management responsibility & oversee performance
  - Deploy competent & adequate resources
  - Ensure appropriate maintenance
