

Construction Safety Week 2019 Safety Video Competition

Background

To further increase safety awareness of the construction industry, the Development Bureau and the Construction Industry Council co-organise the Safety Video Competition 2019 (the Competition). Through the video sharing, to remind the importance of safety practices to industry stakeholders, join hands to promote and share good safety measures in the construction industry.

Eligibility

Construction companies include consultants, contractors and Joint-Venture (JV) companies.

Category

The competition is divided into two categories and different themes of each category are as follows:

Specific Works Items

- (1) Working at Height
- (2) Lifting and Plant Operation
- (3) Confined Space Works
- (4) Electrical Installations Works
- (5) Lift Shaft works
- (6) Repair, Maintenance, Alterations and Additions Works

General Safety Items

- (7) Construction Safety Related Innovative Video

Requirements

Application shall be on company or project basis.

Submission must be related to construction project and should be able to demonstrate how the category of works has been successfully implemented with proper procedures, enhanced safety measures, etc.

Contents of the submission can include any of the initiatives done but not limited to the followings -

- Key safety and health issues;
- Control procedures such as pictorial loadings, making use of BIM etc.;
- Sound technologies and practices adopted; and
- Performance monitoring and auditing

Rules and Regulations

Video Length:

- Specific Works Items: not more than 2 minutes
- General Safety Items: not more than 1 minute

Format:

- Resolution: high definition video formatted at 1080p
- Format: .MP4, 2D format (not compatible with 3D format)
- Language: Cantonese or English
- Opening and/or closing credits are not required
- Company or organisation's names and logo(s) can be added
- Subtitle script in Chinese and / or English is recommended

Judging Panel

Representatives from the Development Bureau, Construction Industry Council, Hong Kong Construction Association, Labour Department and Occupational Safety and Health Council.

Judging Criteria

- Content (adherence to theme, accuracy of information, demonstration of proper procedures)
- Creativity (creative concept, presentation)
- Affective Impact (the ability to engage viewers)
- Aesthetics (shooting technique, visual appeal)

Awards

- Gold, Silver, Bronze and Merit Awards will be bestowed for each category.
- All reviewed submissions will be posted on the Construction Safety Week webpage (www.safetyweek.hk) and will be rated by the public. The video with the highest number of votes will be awarded the Most Popular Safety Video Award.
- Each award winner will receive a prestigious trophy and a Certificate of Award.

Application deadline

Interested companies / organisations shall complete the E-Application Form and submit the video(s) online (including uploading of the video and at least three still images from the video) through the following website <https://www.safetyweek.hk/web/safetyvideo.php> **by 5:00pm on Friday, 12 April 2019.**

Important Notes

- All entries must be submitted online by close of entries.
- All entries should not contain any material that is obscene, violent, pornographic, defamatory, indecent, disparaging or content that is controversial and inappropriate.
- All entries must be the original works of the participant and does not infringe upon the rights (including intellectual property rights, rights of privacy or confidentiality) of any other parties. Otherwise, it would be disqualified for the Competition. Participants are responsible for all legal liabilities. Shall their entry violate any laws, the Organisers will not be held legally responsible.
- If material like music, image, video or movie clips owned by a third party is used in the entries, the participant must acquire written consent from the copyright owner. The Organisers reserve the right to request written proof of these permissions from any participant if necessary.
- All participants must guarantee that their entries submitted have neither been openly shown, publicised or broadcast in any other media platforms; nor have been involved in any commercial activities or submitted for other competitions.
- Participants must acquire written consent from all personnel participate in the performance to upload the video to the Competition website and to use the entries in any form of media for demonstration, publication, exhibition, promotion, or any non-commercial activities by the Organisers.
- Participants are deemed to consent to the Organisers sharing their videos with the public. The Organisers have the right to post the submissions on public website or other media for non-profit making purposes.
- All decisions made by the Judging Panel and the Organisers are final and binding in all matters relating to the Competition. Participating companies/organisations are expected to abide by whatever decisions made by the Judging Panel and the Organisers.
